Part of the main programme of the association, aiming to expand the national coverage, focused on 3 counties with a high level of social and economic vulnerability – Constanța, Mehedinți, Vâlcea – and granting dedicated and personalized support to a number of 45 institutionalized youth (who are being raised or were raised in the foster care system in Romania), aged between 16 and 26 years.
